Manos a la obra Grades K-1

When children engage in hands-on activities, they are fostering crucial areas of development such as mathematical reasoning, memory, attention to detail, and concentration. These same benefits extend to language learning as well. For many children, learning a new language can be incredibly stressful. However, by adapting the teaching approach to include fun, stress-relieving activities, children become more open and receptive to learning. MANOS A LA OBRA is a task-based class designed to help children work in sequence while reinforcing language through repetition. In this environment, they will learn how to give and follow instructions, collaborate, and achieve goals. Additionally, this class serves as an introduction to the language, incorporating activities such as writing, coloring, and reading to further engage children and build their language skills.

Spanish 101

(An introduction to the language) Grades 2-5

This class is designed for students who have never been exposed to the Spanish language, as well as for those who prefer a slower pace in their language learning journey. Based on our experience, we have observed that some beginners become frustrated when the content or pace of classes feels overwhelming. With this in mind, we have developed this introductory course for Beginning Spanish, which offers a different pace and content structure compared to other classes in the program. The focus of this class is on fostering meaningful learning at a pace determined by the student's needs.

Beginning Spanish Grades 2-9

The Spanish classes are designed for students with little or no prior experience in the language. The course introduces them to basic Spanish vocabulary and expressions used by Spanish-speaking people. Throughout the sessions, students will learn to use simple phrases to identify, understand, and inquire about situations, people, and places. The focus will be on using the target language to meet immediate communication needs. Students will be able to introduce themselves and others, as well as ask for and provide basic personal information. Additionally, they will be able to engage in elementary conversations when the speaker communicates slowly and clearly.

iHablando Ando! (Conversational Spanish) Grades 5-9

This class is designed to lay the foundation for students to become bilingual. Students will engage in enjoyable and engaging activities to communicate in Spanish. They will begin to develop their Spanish proficiency through extensive interaction in the target language. The course emphasizes oral communication, with a strong focus on speaking and listening skills, while also covering reading and writing. Culture is an integral part of the curriculum, introduced through media, games, readings, and class discussions. The primary goals are to improve pronunciation and oral proficiency.

iDe fiesta en fiesta! (Spanish Through Traditions) Grades 3-6

This Spanish class invites children to explore the richness of the Spanishspeaking world through its most iconic traditions. Each week, students discover a different celebration or cultural practice—such as Día de Muertos in Mexico, La Feria in Spain, or El Carnaval de Barranquilla in Colombia—while learning related vocabulary, expressions, and cultural context. Lessons are delivered through vibrant visuals, storytelling, songs, and teacher-guided interaction, all adapted for online learning. Students develop their listening and speaking skills while gaining cultural awareness and curiosity about the world. No prior Spanish experience is needed—just a willingness to explore. From food and music to symbols and stories, this class brings Spanish to life through the traditions that make each country unique.

iHablemos claro!

(Conversation in Spanish for Teens – Real Topics, Real Talks) Grades 6-9

This class is designed for middle and early high school students who want to strengthen their communication skills in Spanish. Through dynamic conversations, real-world themes, and student-centered discussions, learners build confidence while expanding their vocabulary and fluency. Each session offers opportunities to express opinions, ask and answer questions, describe experiences, and interact naturally in Spanish. Topics are relevant to teens' everyday lives—covering friendships, routines, culture, preferences, and more. The focus is not on grammar drills, but on helping students use the Spanish they already know—and learn more as they go. Whether students are preparing for Spanish 1 or 2, or simply want to speak more comfortably, this class gives them the structure and space to do just that: speak clearly and with purpose.

iHola, mundo! (Spanish for beginners – vocabulary, expressions & communication) Grades 2-5

This is a beginner-level Spanish class designed for elementary kids. This twice-a-week program introduces young learners to essential vocabulary, useful expressions, and simple conversation patterns in Spanish. Through visual cues, repetition, and teacher-led practice, students learn how to greet others, describe themselves and their surroundings, talk about daily routines, and express likes and preferences. Lessons are structured to support listening and speaking in a playful yet purposeful way, helping students develop confidence from day one. The course is ideal for children with little or no prior exposure to Spanish and focuses on creating a strong, practical foundation for real-world communication—starting with the very first "iHola!"

Creative Writing in Spanish Grades 7-12

This course is designed to enhance language skills through reading, analyzing, and writing literature in Spanish. It provides excellent practice for individuals looking to advance their Spanish proficiency. Through consistent practice, students will improve both the syntax and semantics of the language. Their writing will not only serve as a tool for practicing Spanish but will also help them develop broader writing skills.

Beyond Basic Spanish Grades 5-9

This class is designed for students with prior experience in the Spanish language, whether gained through a bilingual program, from a Spanishspeaking family, or through any other form of exposure to the language. The course primarily focuses on strengthening oral comprehension and conversational skills, enabling students to communicate more fluently and confidently.

Students will engage in a variety of interactive activities aimed at consolidating the skills they have acquired at the introductory level. These activities will encourage active participation, including discussions, roleplaying, and real-world scenarios, helping students build practical language proficiency. Throughout the course, students will expand their vocabulary, refine their grammar, and practice speaking in authentic contexts, thus increasing their overall Spanish proficiency.

Spanish 1 A-G Spanish course Grades 9-12

Spanish 1 is designed as an introductory course for beginners, and as such, will establish a strong foundation and promote future success in Spanish learning for years of study to come. The course will provide the student with a general introduction to the Spanish language: sound system, pronunciation, functional vocabulary related to everyday life, cultural information, and basic grammatical structures. The two main objectives of the course are to provide students with the ability to maintain a simple conversation with a correct understanding of vocabulary and grammatical rules, as well as to teach them the basics of Latin American culture.

Spanish 2 A-G Spanish course Grades 9-12

Prerequisites: Spanish 1 or instructor approval upon completion of the placement test.

The Spanish 2 course will reinforce the Spanish language skills taught on previous levels, emphasizing pronunciation, and increasing communicative abilities. Students also will be exposed to past and future tenses, and they will be expected to apply them in their writing assignments as well as their speaking. The course is focused on listening, speaking, reading, and writing. This is a class with lots of speaking and classroom interaction!

Emphasis on perfecting pronunciation, mastery of the basic grammatical structures, and increased communicative proficiency.

AP Spanish Review A-G Spanish course

Grades 9-12

This course is designed to help students prepare for the AP Spanish Language and Culture exam. Through comprehensive review sessions, students will strengthen their speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills, focusing on the key themes and topics covered in the AP exam. We will engage in practice exercises, mock exams, and thematic discussions to reinforce grammar, vocabulary, and cultural knowledge. The course will emphasize refining students' ability to communicate effectively in Spanish, with special attention to oral proficiency, written expression, and critical listening. This review class is ideal for students looking to boost their confidence and readiness for the AP Spanish exam.

Imagin-Arte Grades 3-6
